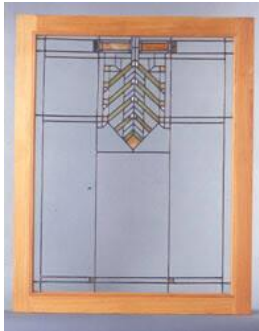

**Primary Maker:** Frank Lloyd Wright  
**Medium:** Stained glass

**Date:** ca. 1819-1830  
**Primary Maker:** Frederick Marquand  
**Medium:** Coin silver



**Title:** Vase

**Primary Maker:** Newcomb College Pottery  
**Medium:** Glazed ceramic



**Title:** Basket  
**Date:** ca. 1850-1856  
**Primary Maker:** Horton & Rikeman  
**Medium:** Coin silver



**Title:** Rocking chair  
**Date:** ca. 1830-1860  
**Primary Maker:** Unidentified African-American in Georgia  
**Medium:** Hickory, yellow pine, split oak, and probably ash and soft maple



**Title:** Urn  
**Date:** 1768 CE  
**Primary Maker:** Emick Romer  
**Medium:** Sterling silver and horn



**Title: Writing chair**  
**Date:** 1840 CE  
**Primary Maker:** Unidentified maker  
**Medium:** Yellow pine, birch, and ash



**Title: Secretary and bookcase**  
**Date:** c. 1800-1820  
**Primary Maker:** Unidentified maker, Lower Southern Piedmont, possibly Augusta, Georgia  
**Medium:** Birch, walnut, yellow pine, holly, brass, and ivory or bone



**Title: Chest over drawers**  
**Date:** c. 1740-1790  
**Medium:** Primary woods: Red gum or sweet gum. Poplar sides. Secondary woods: oak drawer interiors and southern yellow pine back and interior framing



**Title: Mantel clock**  
**Date:** ca. 1850  
**Primary Maker:** New Haven Clock Company  
**Medium:** Mixed woods, metals, and glass



**Title: Pitcher**  
**Date:** c. 1836  
**Primary Maker:** Baldwin Gardiner  
**Medium:** Silver



**Title: Teapot**  
**Date:** c. 1819-1830  
**Primary Maker:** Frederick Marquand  
**Medium:** Silver with wooden handle



**Title: Drop-leaf table, or Pembroke table**  
**Date:** c. 1795-1815  
**Primary Maker:** Unidentified maker, lower Southern piedmont  
**Medium:** Primary wood: cherry; secondary wood: southern yellow pine; inlay: lightwood, possibly sycamore



**Title: Arm chair with rockers**  
**Date:** ca. 1780-1830  
**Primary Maker:** Unidentified maker, Virginia or Georgia  
**Medium:** Unidentified hardwoods



**Title: Water dipper from Ivanhoe Plantation, Burke County, Georgia**  
**Date:** c. 1820-1850  
**Primary Maker:** Unidentified maker  
**Medium:** Coconut shell, unidentified wood and silver



**Title:** Chest of drawers  
**Date:** ca. 1830-1860  
**Primary Maker:** Thomas Day  
**Medium:** Walnut, poplar, and yellow pine



**Title:** Olive spoon  
**Date:** c. 1850  
**Primary Maker:** J. Hayden  
**Medium:** Coin silver



**Title:** Water dipper

**Primary Maker:** Unidentified maker  
**Medium:** Silver and unidentified wood, possibly a close-grained exotic wood

**Title:** Windsor chair  
**Date:** 1800-1840  
**Primary Maker:** Unidentified maker  
**Medium:** Hickory or ash stiles, probably soft maple arms, probably poplar seat, and unidentified ring-porous hardwoods



**Title:** Embroidered coverlet  
**Date:** c. 1815-1830  
**Primary Maker:** Unidentified maker, antecedent of Michael Kaufold  
**Medium:** Colored thread on Manchester cloth with fringe



**Title:** Slab table  
**Date:** ca 1790-1830  
**Primary Maker:** Unidentified maker  
**Medium:** Yellow pine



**Title:** Basket  
**Date:** c. 1850-1900  
**Primary Maker:** Unidentified maker  
**Medium:** Oak splints and river cane



**Title:** Corner cupboard  
**Date:** c. 1790 - 1830  
**Primary Maker:** Unidentified maker  
**Medium:** Yellow pine



**Title:** Mantel, from the Cherokee-built, pre-removal home of John Martin near Cartersville in Murray County, Georgia

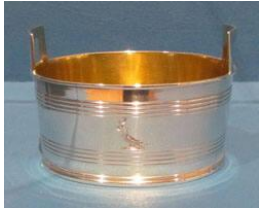
**Title: Side table**

**Medium:** Coin silver

**Medium:** British standard sterling silver



**Title: Fancy Chair**

**Primary Maker:** Thomas Renshaw

**Medium:** Maple and walnut with painted and gilt ornament and cane seats



**Title: Vase**

**Date:** c. 1890

**Primary Maker:** Studio of William Lycett, Atlanta, Georgia

**Medium:** Porcelain decorated with paint and gilt



**Title: Summer quilt or quilt top**

**Date:** c. 1850-90

**Primary Maker:** Unidentified maker, likely a member of the Comer, Howard, or Randolph families of Oglethorpe, Jackson and Clarke counties of Georgia

**Medium:** Cotton
