

## **Nuinobe-do and accessories (two armguards, backplate, breastplate, thigh guard, two shoulder guards, two leg guards)**

late 16th - early 17th centuries

**Primary Maker**

**Medium**

Metal and fabric

**Description**

Armor of mail and plates sewn onto a fabric backing. The dark brown suit of armor has the main body armor (do) with five-plate shoulder guards over mail and lacquered gote (armored sleeves). With mannequin (torso and head) for display. See also 1967.1796.1-4 (2 chain mail shirts, mannequin torso & head); 1967.1798.1-2 (helmet, back/shoulder assembly); 1967.1799 (face/throat guard).
