A Neolithic pottery mortuary urn, Banshan type, the thinly potted full ovoid body standing on a flat base from tapering sides, the upper section painting with a bold frieze of black arabesques framing reserves of dot framed by circular dot collar on red field, above a band of swagged lines and projecting loop handles, the short flared neck with black field.
