Description
Grey ceramic earthenware wine vessel of a reclining ram with head back, tubular body with incised vertical banding similar to cocoon jars from this period, a tubular opening behind neck would have been filled with water or wine, then poured from the small tail in the back like a spout, four legs are folded underneath the body, any details of face or most of paint has been lost.
