### Description

From "One Hundred American Paintings" ... "In 'Tallulah Falls' Cooke shows three of the four main falls at Tallulah: L'Eau d'Or, Tempesta, and Hurricane. His composition stresses verticality, emphasizing the numerous trees, steep cliffs, and cascades of water. On a rocky outcropping, overlooking the gorge and the falls, seven tourists (four women and three men) and a small dog have worked their way down to view the scenery" (39).
